

## WINGSPAN A/V UNMANNED AERIAL SYSTEMS (UASs, aka DRONES) TERMS OF SERVICE

Aerial footage that was once confined to big budget cinema is now within reach for smaller entities to empower viewers with an entirely new perspective. This is an exciting time that brings with it new risks. The following is a list of regulations put forth that you should know about if you're considering an aerial shoot. These practices keep safety paramount and are there to protect both your business and your personal well-being.

- Unmanned Aerial Systems (UAS, aka Drones) cannot exceed an altitude of 400'  
(NOTE: this has exceptions depending on your location. Ask Wingspan A/V for more info.)
- All UAS operation within 5 miles of an airport must obtain permission from Air Traffic Control before flying  
(NOTE: this approval can take up to 90 days depending on the size of the airport. Ask Wingspan A/V for more info.)
- UASs cannot fly directly over the head of anyone (individual or group) not under a protective structure.
- UASs operators must maintain a Visual Line-of-Sight at all times with the drone itself. FPV usage does not qualify as Line-of-Sight.
- No Wingspan A/V UAS can operate in rain as it poses a serious flight risk to both equipment and bystanders.
- Wingspan A/V UASs cannot operate in winds greater than 25 MPH as they compromise safety.
- All UAS operators must obtain a Section 107 license from the FAA. (Good news is we have this covered!)
